

Ujala Welfare Society (Roshani Committee)

Ujala Welfare Society was established in village Mohibullah Kakki (khojri) UC Kakki II on 30.09.2009. A community support group was also formed by this CBO. It also helped and formed VO, Kakki youth, and Progressive Development Forum. Registered in August 2011 Under 1960 Ordinance as non-profit & non govt. organization. The leadership of the CBO is an example of volunteerism and activism. They are fairly active in mobilizing external support.

Besides facilitating its own formation and development with support of CMDO it also helped it in CBO formation in other villages. To the benefit of 1200 persons, it implemented a drinking water supply schemes (DWSS) from CMDO with a 20 % community share to the extent of Rs. 37000. It facilitated the village PRA and participated in the implementation which was a practical experience in institutional capacity building and participatory development. It nominated three trainees from the community who were then trained in different vocational skills. It also nominated youth of the village who were sent on an exposure visit to CBOs and NGOs in various regions such as Sindh, Baluchistan, AJK etc.

The CBO also works with other organizations for the development activities. It facilitated and participated in trainings conducted by Khwendo Kor (KK) viz. proposal writing, participatory development, disaster management, advocacy lobbying, social organization, negotiation skill building, and project cycle management. A Child Protection Centre (CPC) was formed with support from KK where children take part in studies and healthy activities including sports. Assistance was provided to 15 children of CPC in the shape of school uniform and stationery. The teachers / facilitators of the CPC are working as volunteer. An electricity transformer was obtained from Asia Fund for the village with 20 % share from the community. With support from KK health hygiene kits costing Rs. 4500 were provided to three poor community members in addition to a medical camp in the village Mohibullah Kakki. A district level Child Right Committee was formed with support from SPARC. The CRC is meant for oversight of child rights situation, reports, advocacy and lobbying on child rights. It helped to form the district level disaster management committee and is participating in its activities through its members. The polio teams are also being helped in house to house administration of drops, including working with refusal cases and influencing leaders and parents for allowing the administration of drops. Moreover, the BISP teams have been facilitated in its house to house survey.

In addition, a No of activities are being carried out on self help basis and with support of other organizations: such as;

- Five makeshift bridges were built on self help.
- Package of one bag wheat seed one bag DAP to poor farmers.
- Working for crimes control small arms aerial firing in consultation with concerned police station. Also working for conflict resolution through jirga.
- Conducted a survey of drugs /narcotics and is available with the CBO for use.
- Secured disabled certificate from Social Welfare Deptt for disabled persons.
- Provided interest free loan to two persons (5000 each) at the level of village.
- Women of the area are being supported in CNIC by way of facilitating a NADRA mobile Kiosk.
- Made birth certificate for children of members through the Nazim.
- Made domicile certificate for several students.
- Conducting voter registration campaign for Elections.
- Training from agriculture deptt through support of KK
- Worked in canal cleaning campaign of irrigation deptt in the village
- Worked for environment.
- Health and hygiene awareness and Hepatitis B and C awareness and facilitations.
